INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The HB&T Large Cap Blend Index Fund is invested in a pooled collective fund managed by Barclays Global Investors (BGI) and is structured to produce returns that are consistent with the Russell 1000 Index. The Index Fund attempts to duplicate the investment performance of the Russell 1000 by owning all of the 1000 common stocks appropriately weighted and represented by the Russell 1000 Index.

Index Description

The Russell 1000 Index is a capitalization-weighted index consisting of approximately 1000 Mid and Large Cap domestic companies. The Russell 1000 Index is a blend of both growth and value oriented companies with no particular bias given to either style. Component companies are adjusted for available float and must meet objective criteria for inclusion to the index. Reconstitution for the index is annual.
